## Entrance Requirements for Year 13

Students must have **5 GCSEs**, at grade C, or above. In addition, students must have at least **2 Grade Bs**. Students entering the Sixth Form must have a minimum of **11 points** in their GCSE exams. The point system works as follows:

<b>A*</b>	<b>4 points</b>
<b>A</b>	<b>3 points</b>
<b>B</b>	<b>2 points</b>
<b>C</b>	<b>1 point</b>

### **Students wishing to enter Year 13 should also have:**

- At least **grade 'C'** in **English** at GCSE Level.
- A minimum attendance rate of **93%** and a good punctuality record. Students whose attendance rate falls below this level must produce medical evidence to explain their absence.
- A good record of behaviour and should have demonstrated a positive attitude to learning. They should have an excellent attitude towards the wearing of school uniform.
- Commitment to participate fully in the daily running of the school.

When GCSE results are issued in August, all students should make an appointment for interview, at the College Office.

Students transferring from other schools must bring result slips, and, or, certificates, to interview, in August of the proposed year of entry.
